CM interacted with the students of South Tripura district

Students must keep up with the government's various development programs besides academic studies: CM



In order to be successful in life, students must keep up with current state of affairs in the country as well as in foreign countries on a daily basis besides their academic studies, stated Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb in an interactive session with students of Sabroom, Belonia and Santirbazar College of South Tripura district at Sachin Debbarman Auditorium in Belonia yesterday. He said, students must have knowledge about various government schemes and projects and various developmental decisions of the government besides their academic lessons.

The Chief Minister said, success will come only if first and foremost one tries to know themselves, to develop the good quality that they already have in them besides focusing on academic studies. He also said, one must think positive all the time. Negative thoughts bring oneself down. A mother knows about what their child is good at, which is why mothers need to be given some time. Mentioning Mission Vidyajyoti, he said, this is a historic step in the history of Tripura. This is the first time that CBSE syllabus is being introduced by bringing 125 schools in the state under Mission Vidyajyoti. The infrastructural development of the schools is being done. He said, even tea garden worker's son is becoming a TCS officer after sitting for the TPSC examination all because of transparent recruitment policy. It is the first in Tripura. 33% of women reservation has been ensured in government services for empowerment of women.

The Chief Minister said, a Forensic University is being opened in Tripura where 3,000 students will get the opportunity to study. Students from the country and abroad will also study here. The Chief Minister urged the students to read the Prime Minister's and the Chief Minister's tweets. The Chief Minister also waved the flag and launched five ambulance services at the premises of Belonia Circuit House on the same day. The ambulances were purchased by South Tripura Disaster Management Authority at a cost of 7 lakh 85 thousand 585 rupees each.
