Legal Services Camp organized in Santirbazar

With an aim to generate awareness regarding various welfare schemes of the government and extend benefits to the entitled beneficiaries, a Legal Aid Services Camp was held in collaboration with Santirbazar Sub-Divisional Administration and District Legal Services Authority, South Tripura under the aegis of Tripura State Legal Services Authority at Madhya Pilak High School under Jolaibari RD Block on February 27. The camp was organized to mark the 25 years of legal services in the state. The camp was inaugurated by Sub-Divisional Magistrate Abhedananda Baidya in presence of Chief Judicial Magistrate, South Tripura A.K. Singh.

While speaking on the occasion, SDM Abhedananda Baidya said, earlier people used to face lots of problem for getting proper official documents from the administration, now the local administration is taking every step to reach people to provide government services, which is why such camps are organized on public interest.

Speaking on the occasion Chief Judicial Magistrate Sunil K. Singh also emphasized upon the need of awareness of free legal services and support available for the beneficiaries from District Legal Services Authority. Later, about 177 pamphlets containing information on legal aid were also distributed to the participants. PRIs, chairman and members of Gram Panchayat, Village Committee, Anganwadi workers and ASHA workers also have participated in the camp. A medical camp was also organised during the event where about 78 patients have got their health checked up.

Santirbazar SDM handed over various certificates to the beneficiaries like 16 ST certificates, 73 PRTC, 38 income certificates, 150 Aadhar cards and 2 marriage certificates were during the programme. The Forest department also distributed about 100 tree saplings to the participants. Fire safety procedures were demonstrated before the public by the Fire Service department during the event. Different line departments also took part from Santirbazar such as ICDS, Fishery, Health & Family Welfare, Block Development Office, Child Helpline, Department of Police, Fire Station, Agriculture and Labour department and set up their respective stalls carrying information regarding government schemes, developmental work plans and activities. Others present during the event were Dr Abhijit Das, BDO, Jolaibari, CMO, South Tripura, Sri Mitra Das, Legal Committee, Chairman and other officials.
