Agriculture standing committee meeting of West Tripura Zila Parishad

Agriculture standing committee meeting of West Tripura Zila Parishad was organized at the conference hall of the Zila Parishad. The meeting was presided over by Sabhadhipati Antara Sarkar Deb. SahakariSabhadhipatiHaridulal Acharya, other members of the committee and officials of different departments were present in the meeting. Official of Division 1 of Water Resources department informed that implementation of 190 work plans is ongoing for extension of water irrigation in the district. Agriculture & Farmers Welfare official in the meeting informed that in the present financial year, 2722.428 MT of Amon paddy has been procured from 1 thousand 201 farmers of Mohanpur, Dukli and Jirania agricultural subdivision of West Tripura district at MSP. So far 8 thousand 545 farmers were brought under Pradhan Mantri FasalBima Yojana. Total 19 thousand 121 farmers of West Tripura district were registered under PMKISAN. Total expenditure was 31 crore 78 lakh 24 thousand rupees. Horticulture & Soil Conservation department official informed that total 10 Ha land if Mandwi and Hezamara agricultural sub-division of West Tripura district was brought under pineapple cultivation in the present financial year under RKVY scheme. So far in the present financial year under Chief Minister PuspaUdyanPrakalp scheme, 65.6 Ha land has been brought under Marigold cultivation, 6.8 Ha under Gladiolus, 10.8 Ha under Tuberose and 0.4 Ha land has been brought under Rose cultivation. ARDD official in the meeting informed that so far in the present financial year, 6 thousand 132 female cows were brought under artificial insemination. Fisheries department official informed that in the present financial year under Pradhan Mantri MatsyaSampada Yojana, target was taken to excavate 101 new ponds out of which 55 ponds were excavated so far. Besides that, under RKVY scheme, target was taken to excavate 28 new ponds out of which 26 ponds were excavated so far. Total expenditure was 13 lakh 52 thousand rupees.
