

Legal Service Camp held in Longtharai Valley on 25 years of Legal Services

A Legal Service Camp held at Dhumucherra Higher Secondary School ground in Dhumucherra under Manu RD Block in Longtharai Valley yesterday as a part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on the occasion of 25 years of Legal Services. The camp was organized under the aegis of Tripura State Legal Service Authority in association with Longtharai Valley Sub-Divisional Legal Service Committee in coordination with the administration and various line departments. Additional District & Sessions Judge, Dhalai district Gautam Sarkar as Chief Guest inaugurated the camp.

Additional District & Sessions Judge, Dhalai district in the camp spoke about the services rendered to the needy and less privileged citizens of the state. He also mentioned recently opened e-Sewa Kendra in Chailengta, Ambassa and Kamalpur Judicial Court office for providing better legal services.
