Stringent action are being taken on complaints: Returning Officer

Stringent action are being taken on complaints brought in notice of the Returning Officer through various channels. Dr. Vishal Kumar, the Returning Officer for 1- West Tripura Parliamentary Constituency through a Press Note intimated that on 13.04.2024 two complaints were received out of which one is disposed and one has been sent for enquiry to the concerned ARO. This includes suspension of a government teacher by the department for taking part in a political campaign. Similarly, proposal for suspension of a pharmacist at IGM hospital has been sent to the parent department for taking part in a political campaign. Both the complaints were resolved within a day.

Acting on the complaint raised by BJP on remarks of a speaker on private life of the leader of other party, the RO has issued a caution notice ensuring that the person refrains from making any such remark and acts in strict compliance of the Model Code of Conduct.

The Police is actively dealing with miscreant causing disturbances in political programme. One such complaint was raised by CPI(M) and such persons causing disturbance have been booked under relevant section of CrPC & Tripura Police Act. The Police is proactively ensuring that such incidents do not occur.

The Administration and the Police are proactively taking steps to maintain peaceful environment. Area domination activities, 24 x 7 Naka checking by civil and police officers, foot patrolling by CAPF, border area checking and frequent raids etc. is being conducted as confidence building measures. Regular patrolling is done at all the vulnerable places and tight security is present at all the places to ensure no untoward incident happens during the election.

The Administration is assuring peaceful environment for the electors.
