



West district District Magistrate Ravel Hemendra Kumar in his welcome speech said that 7 lakh poor families will be benefitted through Chief Minister Covid Special Relief Package Scheme during this pandemic crisis for which the state government has invested 80 crore rupees. Through this scheme 1.5 lakh families of West district will be benefitted. Among them are 77 thousand 98 Antyodaya, priority group, poor APL families and 13 thousand families of other categories will get the benefits through this scheme in Sadar sub division. Food packets will be distributed to each family through ration shops only. Today itself 4 thousand 600 families will be receiving food packets through 42 ration shops in Sadar sub division.

The Chief Minister has handed food packets to some beneficiaries of this scheme in the inaugural programme. Others present in the programme were Agriculture Minister Pranajit Singha Roy and Khadi & Village Industries Commission Chairman Rajib Bhattacharjee.
