SW&SE Minister inaugurates seminar on social pension in Pecharthal Worthy beneficiaries are being given maintaining transparency: SW&SE Minister

An awareness-based seminar was organized for social pension beneficiaries of Pecharthal block at Pecharthal Town Hall today.
