37 villages of North Tripura have been brought under Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan: DM

A total of 37 villages across six blocks of North Tripura district have been brought under the Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan, a significant initiative aimed at improving the infrastructure and living standards in tribal-dominated areas. This was announced by District Magistrate Debopriya Bardhan during a press conference at the District Collector's office yesterday. Approved recently during a Union Ministerial meeting, the campaign targets villages with a minimum population of 500, where atleast 50 percent of residents belong to the tribal community. The initiative will see the implementation of 25 services and projects through 17 different government departments, with the goal of uplifting the socio-economic conditions of these communities. Key services under the campaign include housing, road construction, potable water, solar energy, internet access, LPG gas connections, and skill development training. In addition, projects related to agriculture, horticulture, fisheries, livestock, and forestry will also be introduced to promote sustainable livelihoods. The District Magistrate emphasized that the Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan is a comprehensive effort to ensure holistic development in these tribal areas. ADM Biplab Das and ADM L. Darlong were also present at the press conference.
