Regional Workshop on State Income and Related Aggregates Concludes in Agartala

The 5-day Regional State Income and Related Aggregates workshop, organized at Pragna Bhaban, Agartala, concluded today. The workshop, which commenced on September 23, was inaugurated by Tripura's Statistics Minister Vikas Debbarma.
