Cabinet decision

The first state cabinet meeting under the chairmanship of Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha was held yesterday at the Secretariat. Four decisions were taken in principle during the cabinet meeting. Information & Cultural Affairs Minister Sushanta Choudhury had informed about the cabinet decisions in a press meet later at the Secretariat that the four decisions were taken in principle. These decisions include steps to be taken for improvement of socio-economic condition including facilities in government jobs for Divyangjans of the state. He had also informed that different steps will be taken for the overall development of indigenous people of the state through TRP & PVTG department.

ICA Minister informed that a state health policy will be soon formed for quality improvement of healthcare services in the state. Tripura State IT Policy shall be revived for investment in the state by businessmen of the state as well as outside the state besides improvement of socio-economic condition of the state and generation of work opportunities for jobless people of the state. He said, the State IT Policy was formed in 2017. Its duration has expired recently. He hoped that the state will move further ahead in coming days.
