Activities undertaken to ensure smooth and fair General Election for 2 Tripura East (ST) PC : Returning Officer

To ensure smooth conduct of the General Election to Lok Sabha-2024 the Office of the Returning Officer (RO) for 2 Tripura East(ST) parliamentary constituency is actively involved in various preparatory activities. Today intimating this through a Press Note Saju Vahhed A, Returning Officer for 2 Tripura East (ST) parliamentary constituency added that the Exchange of Election Duty Certificates (EDC) in Form 12B is scheduled on April 22, 2024 at 10:30 AM in the Conference Hall of the District Magistrate's Office, Dhalai, Ambassa. The Postal Voting Centre (PVC) for "Absentee Voters in Essential Services" has become operational on April 21st and will continue on 22nd, and 23rd April, 2024. The Postal Ballot Facilitation Centre (PBFC) for public servants involved in election duty will be available on April 22nd and 23rd, 2024. Meanwhile, a training session for Micro Observers on their role and responsibilities in the election has been conducted on April 21, 2024, at Ambassa Town Hall. The training was held in the presence of the General Observer for Dhalai and Khowai districts and the District Election Officer (DEO), Dhalai. Voter Information Slips (VIS) has been distributed to 91.60% of the total 293,146 voters, covering 268,531 individuals. The remaining distribution will be completed by April 21, 2024. Received complaints relating to home voting and other election-related issues have been promptly addressed by the RO's office to ensure the integrity and fairness of the electoral process.
