Government's strict orders against black marketing of daily commodities

Due to continued heavy rainfall in different areas such as Haflong, Maibong and Badarpur of Assam, the National Highway NH-44 and rail lines have been affected. As a result, the connectivity between Assam-Agartala through road and railway has been severely affected.

In this situation, it has come to the notice of the state administration that few businessmen have illegally increased prices of daily commodities including vegetables, which has put the public in a critical situation. Taking notice of this, the state government has directed all the District Magistrates and Sub-Divisional Magistrates to take necessary action against the practice of black marketing.

It has been informed on behalf of the state government that the DMs and SDMs shall keep vigil on every market in the state and take strict legal actions against businessmen that ask high prices of items in the market. The government seeks cooperation of the public to keep vigilant eye in order to stop such kind of black marketing.
