CM meets HRD Minister, assures support for one-time relaxation demand, new KVs in Tripura

Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura, Shri Biplab Kumar Deb met the Union Minister of HRD, Shri Prakash Javadekar in New Delhi today. Hon'ble Chief Minister raised the extremely important issue of one-time relaxation for recruiting teachers in Tripura with the Hon'ble Union Minister during the meeting and sought his early intervention in the said matter. Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Javadekar assured the Hon'ble Chief Minister that the Union HRD Ministry is actively considering the State Government's proposal to grant the one-time relaxation in qualifying marks and exemption of professional qualification for recruiting teachers and a decision in this regard shall be taken in the best interest of the state of Tripura at the earliest.

Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Biplab Kumar Deb also raised the issue for setting up of two (2) new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in Dharamnagar & Udaipur and upgradation of one Kendriya Vidyalaya in Ambasa for the state of Tripura. Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Javadekar assured full support to the Hon'ble Chief Minister for setting up of these KVs in the state and informed that the proposals for the same received from the State Government in this regard shall be considered by the Union Government for the approval so that these KVs can initiate operating from the next academic session itself.

Hon'ble Union Minister praised the extensive efforts made by the State Government of Tripura in order to make the state into a Shikshit Tripura, Shreshtha Tripura.
