CM Inaugurates Health Council Building to Streamline Medical Services

In a significant move aimed at improving public health services, Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha inaugurated the newly constructed Health Council building at Dr. P. B. Memorial Bhavan in Bidurkarta yesterday. The new facility brings seven health-related council offices under one roof for the first time, a step designed to simplify and expedite services for citizens.

Speaking to reporters after the inauguration, the Chief Minister stated that earlier, the council offices were located in different parts of the health department, causing inconvenience to applicants seeking various medical registrations and services. “This integrated facility will ensure smoother, more efficient service delivery to the public,” he said. The Chief Minister also reiterated the government’s commitment to strengthening the state’s healthcare system, highlighting that doctors are working with dedication and that the new arrangement will further support their efforts. The event was attended by several dignitaries, including Additional Secretary of the Health Department Rajib Datta, President of the State Branch of the Indian Dental Council Dr. S. M. Ali, Vice President Dr. Partha Roy Chowdhury, Dr. Bholanath Saha, and other senior health officials.
