

Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) has completed two years of its launch on 23rd September 2020. Together we could, bring smiles to the lives of several beneficiaries of the State. Since its launch, till August 2020, more than 70 thousand treatments worth Rs. 31.65 crores (including portability cases) have been provided under the scheme in Tripura.

India takes a giant leap towards providing accessible and affordable healthcare to the poor people with the launch of Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan AarogyaYojana (AB-PMJAY). With Ayushman Bharat – PMJAY, the government is taking healthcare protection to a new aspirational level. The Yojana provides a coverage up to Rs. 5,00,000 per family per year, for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization through a network of Empaneled Health Care Providers (EHCP).

This healthcare program is targeting over 10.74 crore vulnerable families more than 50 crore beneficiaries nationwide and approximately 4.90 lakhs identified families covering about 14 lakh beneficiaries in the State of Tripura.

Achievement till 31st August 2020 in Tripura ; at a glance :

Who can avail benefit under the scheme and how?

- The entitlement is being decided on the basis of deprivation criteria in the SECC (Socio Economic Caste census) database. In addition, the Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojna (RSBY) beneficiaries (card issued on or after 2016) are also included.
- There is no cap on family size and age in the scheme.

Process of e-card generation

- Beneficiaries need to establish their identity to avail benefits under the scheme which can also be done through election ID card, ration card, Aadhar Card, Hon'ble PM Letter.
- If any new member needs to be added to a family due to marriage or birth, marriage/birth certificate need to be produced.
- Beneficiaries will get their e-cards at all empanelled hospitals and Common Service Centres all over the State.

What to do after getting e-card

There are 90 empanelled hospitals in Tripura under AB-PMJAY. There are Arogya Mitras in all empanelled hospitals who looks after the technical aspects like registration of patients for availing benefits, e-card generation etc for smooth implementation of AB-PMJAY in each EHCP (Empanelled Health Care Providers). The patient/patient party of AB-PMJAY beneficiaries need to contact with Arogya Mitra of the hospital before admission and after discharge for smooth flow of treatment facilities under the scheme. They are also requested to keep the e-cards with them during admission and discharge. If any emergency admission is required for any beneficiary not having the e-card, then also treatment is possible after immediate issue of e-card and for that necessary documents for e-card generation need to be produced at Hospital AB-PMJAY help desk.

Key Features of PM-JAY:

There is no cap on family size and age as well as restriction on pre-existing conditions. All pre-existing diseases covered.

Every member of empanelled family will be issued separate e-card.

The Yojana will provide a coverage up to Rs. 5,00,000 per family per year, for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization through a network of Empaneled Health Care Providers (EHCP).

The EHCP network will provide cashless and paperless access to services for the beneficiaries at the both public and private hospitals. The services includes 1573 procedures covering pre and post hospitalization, diagnostics, medicines etc. So far 88 public hospitals and 2 private hospitals has been empanelled in Tripura under AB – PMJAY.

Via National Portability feature, a card holder of Tripura can avail cashless treatment in all EHCPs all over India. Beneficiaries may reach out for information, assistance, complaints and grievances to a 24X7 helpline number – 14555 (National) / 18002453797 (Tripura). The

To ensure that every beneficiary of AB-PMJAY gets free treatment, the Indoor wards are being visited and cross checked and if any beneficiary is found then he/she is immediately registered to avail benefits under the scheme. Recently, 8 Arogya Mitras from all 8 districts have been felicitated based on their best performance in programme implementation.

Observing 2nd year completion of AB-PMJAY in Tripura

For Observing the 2nd year completion of AB-PMJAY in Tripura, awareness activities like talk shows, Audio Visual Advt, News paper Advertisement, social media awareness, awareness through jingles will be implemented weeklong from 23rd to 29th September 2020 with a purpose to reach the last mile beneficiary of the scheme so that no one is deprived from the benefits of AB-PMJAY.

All are requested to check their eligibility and get their e-card issued and also are requested to avail the facilities of the scheme as per requirement.
