"Deteriorating 82-Miles PHC reflects Tripura's troubled Healthcare system", under this caption the news item published in Tripura Times on 27.10.2024 has come to the notice of Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Tripura .

The factual report is the construction of the new building began in 2021 under the supervision of the PWD (R&B), Manu division, Longtarai Valley (LTV), Dhalai, Tripura. After completion of the project enhancing of services to be ensured. Power outages has been managed with an inverter system, electricity related problem has been managed. The hospital manages an average of 5 admissions daily and handles approximately 56 patients in the OPD. This reflects the considerable demand for healthcare services in the region.

Drugs and logistics are available in adequate amounts, ensuring that patient care is not compromised. Additionally, the JAS(RKS)/PMJAY funds are being utilized in case of any shortage of drugs and logistics. The hospital maintenance it's cleanliness and provide housekeeping services as per Indian Public Health Standard (IPHS) norms. The construction of staff quarters is also underway, including 2 Type-3 quarters for medical officers, 4 Type-2, and 4 Type-1 quarters. This will greatly improve the living conditions of the health staff stationed at the facility.
