Tripura Urban Livelihood Mission
Awareness and Mega Loan Distribution Camp in Teliamura

In a bid to boost self-reliance and empower women in the community, the Tripura Urban Livelihood Mission, in collaboration with the Teliamura Municipal Council, organized an awareness and mega loan distribution camp at the Chitrangada Art Centre, Teliamura, yesterday. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from members of Area Level Federations and Self-Help Groups (SHGs) across the region. The camp was inaugurated by Kalyani Saha Roy, Chief Whip of the Tripura Legislative Assembly, who emphasized the importance of self-reliance for societal development, particularly through empowering women. “If a mother is self-reliant, the society is also self-reliant,” she remarked. Other dignitaries present included Teliamura Municipality Chairperson Rupak Sarkar, Chief Executive Officer Parimal Majumdar, Deputy Chief Executive Officer Amit Roy Chowdhury, and Tripura Urban Livelihood Mission State Mission Manager Asim Kumar Das. Madhusudan Roy, Vice Chairperson of Teliamura Municipality, presided over the event’s opening ceremony. Welcome speech was delivered by Deputy CEO Amit Roy Chowdhury. A major highlight of the camp was the distribution of loan cheques amounting to Rs 13.1 lakh, allocated to seven self-help groups under the Teliamura Municipal Council. Additionally, three residents were awarded e-rickshaws through the Tripura Urban Livelihood Mission to support sustainable livelihood initiatives. Under the PM SVANidhi scheme, large umbrellas were distributed among 40 street vendors enhancing their ability to operate under various weather conditions, and three small business owners received loans to further develop their business.
