**Assistance to flood affected farmers in winter vegetable cultivation**

In response to the recent floods that impacted several agricultural subdivisions in Khowai district, assistance has been provided to 8,115 affected farmers for winter vegetable cultivation. This initiative, aimed at restoring livelihoods and ensuring food security, offers support to farmers for the cultivation of essential winter crops, including cauliflower, cabbage, carrot, tomato, and brinjal. Under this program, each farmer received vegetable seeds worth Rs. 1,000 to aid in re-establishing their fields. The distribution spans over multiple subdivisions within Khowai district: 1,027 farmers in Khowai agricultural sub-division, 263 in Padmabil, 246 in Tulasikhar, 2,656 in Kalyanpur, 3,162 in Teliamura, and 761 in Mungiakami. Sabendra Debbarma, Deputy Director of the District Horticulture and soil Conservation Office has given this information.
