

Commencement of training camp on processing of Muli Bamboo cookies

A three day training camp on processing of Muli Bamboo cookies has commenced since yesterday at BCDI conference hall at Lichubagan, Agartala. The training programme was inaugurated by Kiran Gitte, Secretary, Industry and Commerce Department. After inaugurating the programme Mr. Gitte said, ‘ This kind of programme has been organised to encourage the great initiative of processing Muli bamboo cookies’. He briefed about the financial assistance provided under different schemes such as Swabalamban, P.M.E.G.P, N.B.M and P.M.F.M.P. He also urged the participants to take initiatives in the state to process Muli bamboo cookies. 34 aspirant entrepreneurs participated in the training that day. The training will continue upto 7th October, 2020. Apart from the processing of Muli bamboo cookies, training on business, financial economy and planning will also be provided to the participants. They will also be oriented about the financial assistance available under different schemes. This training programmes has been conducted by BCDI with the financial assistance of National Bamboo Mission (N.B.M) and with the sponsorship of Tripura Bamboo Mission (T.B.M). The Muli bamboo cookies were launched officially by the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb on 18th September, 2020 on World Bamboo Day.
