6-Day Akankha Mela opens in Kanchanpur

The 6-day Akankha Mela started on July 28 at the Subhashnagar Panchayat ground in Kanchanpur. This event was organized as part of the Aspirational Block Program of NITI Aayog on the occasion of the Sampurnata Abhiyan Samman.
