**Governor Visits Bagmara Agri producers
Company Limited in Bagmara**

On 29 July 2025: Governor Indrasena Reddy Nallu visited Bagmara Agriproducers Company Limited in Bagmara to inspect various ongoing activities. During his visit, the Governor observed the Model Integrated Farming System, which combines pig farming, fishery, poultry, beekeeping, and goat rearing under one setup. He toured the milk collection center, oil extraction unit, BAPCL mart, and various product exhibition stalls. The Governor also interacted with farmers and farm workers.

Speaking at the event, Governor Indrasena Reddy Nallu said that agriculture is the lifeline of Tripura and the foundation of the state's economy. However, to keep the agricultural sector profitable in a rapidly changing world, the adoption of scientific methods is essential. He noted that the Integrated Farming System operated by BAPCL is a model of climate resilience and efficient resource utilization.
