Section 144 imposed in Indo-Bangladesh border in Khowai sub-division

The District Magistrate & Collector of Khowai district L.T. Darlong has imposed restriction on movement of people in Indo-Bangladesh border in Khowai sub-division. According to the order U/S 144 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, movement of people is prohibited along 500 (five hundred) Metres of Indo-Bangladesh International Border of Khowai sub-division during the odd hours along border areas to prevent danger to human life, public property and tranquility between 8 pm to 5 am. However, this prohibitory order shall not be applicable to the movement of Military, Para-Military Force and the State Police personnel engaged in maintenance of Law and Order; movement of the members of public authorized by the Superintendent of Police, Khowai district and Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khowai; movement of Government servants when it is essential for discharge of emergent official duties and movement of patients requiring immediate treatment. Any person violating the Order shall be liable to be prosecuted U/S 188 of I.P.C. The above restriction shall come into force with effect from June 9, 2022 and shall remain in force up to August 7, 2022.
