Tribal Welfare Minister inaugurates administrative cum health camp in Karbook

The government is working with plans for the welfare of the indigenous people: Tribal Welfare Minister

An administrative cum health camp and interaction programme was organized at the BRC Hall of Karbook Panjiham Higher Secondary School yesterday. The camp was inaugurated by Tribal Welfare Minister Rampada Jamatia. After inaugurating the programme, he said, this kind of camp is being organized to generate awareness among the indigenous people about various welfare schemes taken by the central and the state government. The public can avail various administrative and healthcare opportunities being provided during the camp. He said, the central and the state government is sincere towards the welfare of the indigenous people. The government has taken several plans for the welfare of the indigenous people such as setting up of Eklavya Schools to increase the quality of education in tribal populated areas, construction of roads and providing drinking water supply etc.

MDC of TTAADC Bhumikananda Reang, Chairman of Karbook Block Advisory Committee Asim Tripura, Gomati District Magistrate Raval Hemendra Kumar and Karbook SDM Partha Das were also present in the programme. The guests interacted with beneficiaries of different welfare schemes of the government. At the end of the programme, tree saplings planting programme was held on the occasion of World Environment Day with the initiative of the sub-division administration. Tribal Welfare Minister Rampada Jamatia planted a tree sapling in the programme. Later, he also had participated in Shad Bhokhon ceremony organized by Karbook ICDS. Total 302 patients of Karbook block area have got their health checked up in the health camp. Free blood tests were done and Covid-19 vaccination were given. Applications for 119 PRTC, 89 ST, 15 marriage certificates and 6 income certificates were taken on behalf of the sub-division administration. An awareness based drama was also played as a part of PRAYAS by the Police administration in the camp.
