**Entire society will benefit from Swasth Nari
Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan: Agriculture Minister**

Yesterday, while speaking at a program organized at Mohanpur Community Health Centre to inaugurate the Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan', Agriculture Minister Ratanlal Nath said this. He said that 7,423 camps will be organized in the state as part of the Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan. In many of these camps, specialist doctors will be present to provide health services to the patients. In addition, blood donation camps will also be organized. Needless to say, the entire society will benefit from this. The Agriculture Minister said, the Prime Minister has said that the dream of a developed India rests on four pillars. These pillars are women, youth, farmers and people from the backward sections of the society. The central government is working to ensure that these four pillars can be developed in different aspects. Agriculture Minister Ratanlal Nath requested all the women to participate in the health service program that will be taken up as part of the Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan.

MP Rajib Bhattacharya said at the event that the Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyan has been started so that mothers can stay well. He expressed gratitude to the Prime Minister for launching this program and taking a special role in the development of the North Eastern region including Tripura. Fruits and sweets were distributed among all the patients of the community health centre. Protein-based food items were also given to the TB patients. As part of this program, a health camp was also organized at the Mohanpur Community Health Center today. In this, specialist doctors from various departments treated 160 patients and provided them with free medicines.
