**Implementation of Reduction in GST on  
Medical Products and Display of Revised Prices**

The Government of India has recently taken a decision regarding rationalization of Goods & Services Tax (GST) rates on drugs, formulations and medical devices. The reduced GST rates will come into effect from **22.09.2025**.

In this regard, the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) has issued directions **Vide File. No. DC-DT-15011(11)/122/2025 dated 11.09.2025** and the National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) has issued further instructions **Vide OM No. 1224/2021/DP/NPPA/Div. II (Vol-II)-Part(I) dated 12.09.2025 and 13.09.2025**.

As per these directions:

- **Re-stickering or re-labelling of available stock is not mandatory**, since it may cause disruption or shortage of medicines and medical devices.
- However, **all manufacturers, importers, wholesalers, distributors, and retailers must ensure that revised price lists/supplementary price lists (Form V/VI) reflecting the reduced GST rates and revised MRPs are issued, displayed, and made available to consumers.**
- These directions must be implemented in letter and spirit so that the benefit of reduced GST is directly passed on to the consumers.

Consumers in Tripura are advised to check the displayed revised price lists in retail medical shops and outlets, which will reflect the reduced prices due to GST rationalization.

The Office of the Deputy Drugs Controller, Government of Tripura, urges all stakeholders to ensure immediate compliance so that the benefit of GST reduction reaches the public in a timely manner. This was informed by the Directorate of Family Welfare & P.M. through a press release.

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
