**Formation of High-Level Task Force headed by Chief Minister
on Promotion of Investment in North East India**

The Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER) has constituted a high-level task force to promote investment in North East India. The task force is headed by Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha as the Convener. Other members include the Union Minister of DoNER and the Chief Ministers of Meghalaya, Nagaland and Sikkim. The primary objective of this task force is to develop a comprehensive road map to establish North East India as a preferred investment destination. The plan to be submitted within the next six months, will focus on key sectors such as investment climate, infrastructure development, agriculture, tourism, logistics, IT and renewable energy. Key initiatives under the proposed road map include the creation of agro-processing zones, tourism circuits, IT parks and renewable energy corridors. Additionally, strategies for attracting both domestic and international investments will be formulated, emphasizing Public-Private Partnership (PPP) models and necessary policy reforms to enhance sectoral growth and investment potential. The decision to form this high-level task force was taken during the 72nd plenary meeting of the North Eastern Council, held on 21st December 2024, in Agartala.
