Over 5,300 Self-Help Groups Formed in Khowai District Under TRLM

The Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission (TRLM) has made remarkable progress in strengthening rural livelihoods by forming 5,362 self-help groups (SHGs) across six block areas in Khowai district during the last financial year. According to the Khowai District Mission Management Office, a total of 48,442 families have been brought under the self-help group network. The SHGs were formed in the following blocks: 1,170 in Teliamura, 995 in Tulasikhar, 813 in Kalyanpur, 640 in Padmabil, 503 in Mungiakami, and 1,241 in Khowai. Financial assistance has also been provided to strengthen these groups. A revolving fund amounting to Rs 8.90 crore has been disbursed to 4,470 SHGs under the first gradation. Additionally, Rs 56.21 crore was distributed to 4,465 SHGs under the second gradation of the micro credit plan within just six months of their formation. These groups fall under 18 cluster-level federations spread across the six blocks.
