Secretary (CPV & OIA), Ministry of External Affairs calls on Chief Minister, Tripura

On 5th July 2022, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Manik Saha received an Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) delegation led by Dr. Ausaf Sayeed, Secretary (CPV&OIA) who was leading a high level delegation of the Ministry for state outreach program.
