Padmashri Dipa Karmakar honoured with Tripura Vibhushan Samman

Tripura Vibhushan Samman has been awarded to Padmashri Dipa Karmakar for her remarkable contribution to sports. The Government of Tripura on the occasion of Statehood Day, for the first time in the state has introduced the Rajya Nagarik Samman 2021. Governor Ramesh Bais handed over the Tripura Vibhushan Samman to Dipa Karmakar in the Statehood Day programme organised at Rabindra Shatabarshiki Bhawan hall no.1. As part of the award she also received a cash prize of Rs. 5 lakh along with a certificate, a memento and a Risa. Tripura Bhushan Samman went to to little master Arshiya Das. The Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb handed over the award to Arshiya Das in the Statehood Day programme for her outstanding contribution to sports.
