Police Commemoration Day observed

Our security forces would continue to perform their duty diligently: CM

Today along with the country, the state also observed Police Commemoration Day. The central programme to mark the Day was organised at the Manoranjan Debbarma Memorial Stadium at Arundhatinagar, Agartala, where the Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha paid floral tribute and respect to the police personnel and janwas who laid their lives in the line of duty. Chief secretary J.K. Sinha, DGP Anurag and other police officials also paid their respect to the martyrs. Special tribute was paid to 191 police personnel of the country including two from the state, who got martyred during the period from September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025. Sub-Inspector David Darlong and TSR jawan Rifleman Milan Debbarma died on duty at Khedachera of Tripura and Chirakuti in Kailashahar respectively. Chief Minister expressed his condolence to the families of the martyrs.

Speaking at the event organised by the home department the Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha said, today is the day to pay our respect and remember our brave police personnel and jawans who laid their lives in the line of duty. He expressed hope that the police personnel, para-military forces, and jawans who are performing their duties diligently, guarding our nation and the borders, would continue to do so in the coming days as well. They are not only protecting our citizens, but also striving to protect sovereignty of the country. It is worth mentioning here that in 1959 on this very day 10 police personnel got martyred in a surprise attack while patrolling at the Hot Spring in Ladakh. To commemorate that day Police Commemoration Day is observed.
