Training Camp for scientific fish farming in Amarpur Sub-Division

A training camp on scientific fish farming was held yesterday in the premise of Amarpur Fisheries Supervisor's office. MLA Ranjit Das inaugurated the training camp. Fishing net and ice box were distributed to the fish farmers in the training camp. In the camp, 36 fish farmers were given fishing net under Mukhyamantri Matsya Vikas Yojana. 86 thousand 400 rupees have been spent for this. Moreover, 16 fish farmers have been given ice boxes under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana. 64 thousand rupees have been spent for this. Inaugurating the training camp, MLA Ranjit Das said that the government is giving training on scientific fish farming to fish farmers to increase fish production in the state. Priority has been given to improve the socio-economic status of fish farmers.
