

Training on "Increasing Productivity of Cross Pollinated Crops through Apiculture"



Under ATMA, training was held at Superintendent of Agriculture of Damcherra office for increasing productivity of cross pollinated crops through apiculture. The training was given by Dr. Kalai of SMS, Panisagar KVK and Tulsi Chakma of SMS, Panisagar KVK. The keynote address was given by Superintendent of Agriculture of Damcherra. He said honey bees increase fruiting through pollination and so increase production. Moreover it produces honey of 8-12 kg from each hives per time which is valued 1200 to 1500 rupees per kg. The guests present at the programme were Chairman of BAC of Damcherra Block Upendra Reang and Vice Chairman Durshanta Reang. After the training, bee-hives were distributed among the trainees. Rs. 4000 per unit will be given as assistance for rearing. This was informed by Superintendent of Agriculture of Damcherra office.
