

Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra
Review meeting at the State Guest House

Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra is starting from November 15 to bring various schemes and services of the Central and State Governments to the people. A review meeting on this program was held at the State Guest House on November 7, 2023. Chief Secretary J.K Sinha and Additional Secretary of Ministry of Coal, Central Government M Nagaraju were present in the meeting.

In the meeting, the Additional Secretary of the central government said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch this program on November 15. In addition to the state government departments, all the central government departments in the state should also come forward to implement this program. He said that 23 sub-divisions of the state will have vehicle resources for this program. Bengali and Kokborok languages should be given priority in the campaign. In this regard, Akashvani and Doordarshan have to play a leading role. In the meeting, Chief Secretary J.K Sinha said that to implement Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra, three-tier panchayat and various departments should work with sincerity.

In the review meeting, the Secretary of the Department of Information and Cultural Affairs Dr. Pradeep Kumar Chakraborty said various insurance schemes including Jandhan Yojana, Atal Pension Yojana, Ayushman Bharat and central flagship schemes and services are included in this Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra. Publicity campaigns will be organized at Gram Panchayat, Village Committee, Urban Area, Block, Sub-Division, District and State level to make this program successful.

In the review meeting, the Secretary of the Department of Information and Culture said that health camps, quizzes, discussions, exchange of views and cultural programs will also be organized in this sankalpa yatra. Apart from this, awareness programs will be taken up among school and college students. Self help group members and members will be made aware. To implement Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra programme, a state level management committee has been formed with the Chief Secretary as chairman and district level management committee with district magistrates as chairman. The Information and Cultural Affairs Department will be the nodal department for the implementation of Bharat Sankalp Yatra program in the state.
