Legal Services Camp held in Kamalpur

To mark the occasion of 25 years of Legal Services, a second term Legal Services Camp was conducted at Janthum English Medium High School ground of Janthum Village Committee under Salema RD Block in Kamalpur on April 9. The camp was organized by Kamalpur Sub-Divisional Legal Services Committee in coordination with sub-divisional administration, BSF contingent, Maracherra and different line departments of the sub-division.

Chief Judicial Magistrate and Ld. District Secretary of Dhalai district Satyajit Das graced the event as an inaugurator and chief guest in presence of Assistant Session Judge of Dhalai district Rahul Roy, Kamalpur SDM Abhijit Chakraborty, Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate Sajan Lal Tripura, Member Secretary of SDLSC Bikash Debbarma, Dr. Kamal Halam of District Hospital, Kulai, and Inspectorate of Schools, Salema Ranjan Mallik. The inaugurator spoke about constitutional and legal services rights provided under State, District and Sub-Divisional Legal Services Committee accessible to every citizen.

Certificates were distributed to the beneficiaries and health kits were distributed to physically challenged persons by the dignitaries. Later the dignitaries visited different stalls. Dr. Kamal Halam conducted a brief discussion on drug abuse and its effects. Inspectorate of Schools, Salema Ranjan Mallik spoke on the context of Right to Education.

It was informed that basic services were delivered during the camp on behalf of SDM office such as PRTC, ST certificate, Aadhar card verification, Income certificates, Marriage certificates. 43 patients received treatment and health assistance from Janthum PHC. 11 physicall challenged persons were benefitted through District Disability Rehabilitation Centre (DDRC), Kulai. 27 persons went through free HIV test through an NGO Prabaha, Dhalai. 67 families benefitted through ARDD department. 25 ROR were issued through Salema BDO office. 48 Zero Balance Accounts were opened by PNB, Halahali Branch. 4 trade licenses for small cap business were issued by Sub-ZDO office, TTAADC. 12 certificates were verified by Legal Meteology, Kamalpur office.
