## Sports goods distribution event in Udaipur Town Hall, Sports Minister has taken initiative to develop modern sports infrastructure in the state: Agriculture Minister

The state government has taken initiatives to bring every child of the state to the sports field. One can get good health through sports, Agriculture Minister Pranajit Singha Roy said this while inaugurating the sports goods distribution programme in Udaipur Town Hall on 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. Initiatives have already been taken to recruit 100 PI. In order to improve the quality of football game, the state will install another 5 to 7 synthetic football ground. An initiative has been taken to give Rs. 20,000 to about 1500 students in the state to purchase sports equipment. He expressed hope that drug free Tripura will be developed through sports. In the event, Sports Minister Sushanta Chowdhury handed over sports equipments to the physical teacher in charge of Kakraban Higher Secondary School.
