Inauguration of two-day camp at Old Agartala Block

As part of Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Prati Ghare Sushason 2.0 campaign, a two-day vikas camp was inaugurated at the block premises in Old Agartala yesterday. MLA Ratan Chakraborty inaugurated this camp. Inaugurating the camp, he said that the main objective of the central and state governments is to improve the quality of life of the poor people. It is for this purpose that Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Prati Ghare Sushason 2.0 campaign has been launched. Exhibition stalls of various departments were opened in the camp to provide various services to the public. On the first day of the camp, 2 farmers were given power tillers, 2 farmers were given paddy weeders and 4 farmers were given spray machines from the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. Apart from this, bicycles were provided to 4 persons from Scheduled Caste Welfare Department, 35 beneficiaries from Animal Resources Development Department were given assistance for rearing chickens. Beneficiaries were given 10 chicken each.
