Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra
Two-day camp in Khowai concluded

Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Prati Ghare Sushason 2.0 campaign concluded yesterday in Khowai. Minister of Tribal Welfare Bikash Debbarma and Minister of Animal Resources Development Sudhangshu Das were present in the camp. The camp was organized on the premises of Radhakrishna Temple in Subhash Park, Khowai. On the concluding day of the two-day camp, Tribal Welfare Minister Bikash Debbarma said that Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Prati Ghare Sushason 2.0 campaign has been launched to give the benefits of various schemes and services of the Central and State Governments to the last person of the society. The government aims to build a self-reliant Tripura.

Animal Resource Development Minister Sudhangshu Das said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra for the overall development of the country and the state. On the concluding day, the Minister of Tribal Welfare and Minister of Animal Resource Development handed over gas connections under Prime Minister Ujjwala Yojana to 11 beneficiaries. In the camp, 104 people of the Municipal Council area have been given gas connection under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. Moreover, 129 people were given ROR, 87 people were given Income, 33 people were ST, 88 were OBC, 64 were given marriage certificates and 3 were given trade license.

In the camp, applications were received from 63 people under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban. Applications were received from 18 people under Pradhan Mantri Vishwakarma Yojana. Moreover, the application forms of 2 farmers under PM-Kisan Yojana have been taken by the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. 105 people were given saplings of various trees from the forest department. 50 people were treated and given necessary medicines from the health department. Ayushman card has been given to 104 people.
