

Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra: Camp in Central Zone of AMC

Government working to extend benefits of various flagship schemes of central government to people of all sections of the community: Chief Minister

Mayor of Agartala Municipal Corporation Deepak Majumder said that such camps have already been completed in North, East and South Zone under the initiative of Agartala Municipal Corporation. About 3000 citizens have benefited from these camps. Eminent philanthropist Rajib Bhattacharya also spoke on the occasion. Commissioner of Agartala Municipal Corporation Dr. Shailesh Kumar Yadav gave the welcome speech.
