## Inauguration of newly constructed pucca building of Taibandal PHC

The government has given special importance to the development of health infrastructure and expansion of advanced health services in the state. The Chief Minister also inaugurated the newly constructed quarter complex of Urmai Primary Health Centre in Sonamura subdivision. There are 10 quarters in this quarter complex.
