

**Standing Committee on Finance of West Tripura
Zilla Parishad Reviews Progress and Sets New Targets**

A meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance of the West Tripura Zilla Parishad was held today at the Zilla Parishad Auditorium. The meeting was presided over by Haridulal Acharya, the Acting President of the Zilla Parishad, and attended by other committee members and officials from relevant departments. During the meeting, a representative from the Small Savings Department highlighted the district's ambitious target of collecting 640 crore rupees in the current fiscal year under the small savings scheme. So far, 107 crore rupees have been collected, compared to the 624 crore rupees collected in the previous financial year. The district's lead bank manager provided updates on various self-employment projects under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana. He reported that 3,58,901 people in West Tripura district are now covered under the Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana, 1,14,033 under the Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana and 52,890 under the Atal Pension Yojana. The secretary of the Zilla Parishad presented a report on the panchayat development initiatives undertaken in the last financial year. Notable projects included the renovation of the Community Hall in the Ballabhpur Panchayat and the Amtali Class XII School in Dukli Block, with an expenditure of Rs 4,85,684. Additionally, a purified drinking water tank was constructed at the Uria Para Anganwadi Centre in Ananda Nagar Panchayat, costing Rs 1,30,876. Looking forward, the secretary announced plans to assist 170 families across five blocks in West Tripura district with goat rearing through the Panchayat Development Fund of the Zilla Parishad, with an allocation of 17 lakh rupees for this initiative. The meeting underscored the ongoing commitment to financial growth and community development in West Tripura district, ensuring continued progress and support for its residents.
