<u>Inauguration of newly constructed pucca building of Chebri Primary Health Centre</u> Government prioritizes improving quality of health services in state: Chief Minister

The government has given priority to improving the quality of health services in the state. Emphasis has also been laid on building better health infrastructure in the state along with improving the quality of health services. Moreover, the government is also giving priority to the expansion of advanced health services in the remote areas of the state. This was said by Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha while formally inaugurating the newly constructed pucca building and quarter complex of Chebri Primary Health Centre in Khowai today. On the occasion, the Chief Minister said, initiatives have been taken to launch 11 super specialty services in GBP Hospital for the development of health services. Already 7 super specialty departments have been launched. 4 crore 65 lakh 28 thousand rupees have been spent on the construction of the pucca building of Chebri primary health Centre with 10 beds.

Speaking on the occasion, Chief Minister Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha said that several steps have been taken to improve the infrastructure of health services in Khowai district. The building of Chebri Primary Health Centre is part of this initiative. He said, earlier people used to go outside the state for better treatment. At present, the state has the facilities to treat various complex diseases. The number of patient referrals from the state has also decreased significantly. Dental college has already started in the state. The infrastructure of IGM Hospital is being further expanded. The number of beds in GBP Hospital is almost being doubled. The Chief Minister said that the benefits of various schemes and services of the Central and State Governments are being delivered to the common people under Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra and Prati Ghare Sushason 2.0 campaign.
