

Inauguration of blood bank at Teliamura sub-divisional hospital

Government gives priority for overall development of the state: CM

This was said by Chief Minister Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha while inaugurating the blood bank of Teliamura sub-divisional hospital in Khowai district on 3rd August, 2022. Programme was organized at Teliamura Town Hall to celebrate the inauguration of Blood Bank at Teliamura Sub-Divisional Hospital.

CM said that the current government is working with special importance for the development of health infrastructure. The government is working towards providing health services to the common people relentlessly from the primary health center to the main hospitals of the state. It is to be noted that the residents of Teliamura sub-division had a long-standing demand to make the Teliamura sub-division hospital more modern. With that goal in mind, the official opening of the blood bank was held on 3rd August, 2022. After inaugurating the blood bank, Chief Minister was informed about the various problems of the hospital. Chief Minister assured to solve all these problems very soon. Chief Minister also said that there is a shortage of specialist doctors in the state at present and many of them have retired. However, the state government is serious about solving all these issues. Chief Minister said that the state government has taken initiative to open an operation theater in Teliamura hospital. The state government will also take initiatives to improve the health services in Teliamura Sub-Divisional Hospital in the future.

Dr. Saha said that apart from health services, the state government has given priority to the overall development of the state.
