Inauguration of computer lab at Vivekananda Shishu Niketan, Bishalgarh

Real development of society is possible only through empowerment of women: Chief Minister

Real development of society is possible only through women empowerment. The government is giving priority to women empowerment in the state, today women of the country are proving their excellence in all fields from education to sports. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' campaign is being implemented across the country said CM Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha at the felicitation ceremony of the students of Vivekananda Shishu Niketan H.S School in Bishalgarh. Chief Minister said that four students of this school have passed with flying colors in board exam this year. This is the proof of the achievements of the girls of the state in their studies.

Chief Minister told the students that they must have proper knowledge about their school. They must be disciplined. Also teachers and elders should be respected. He told the students that work should always be completed on time, it makes future work much easier. He said that not only studies should be done, sports should also be continued along with studies. It is possible to build a healthy body and a healthy mind through sports. He urged the students to stay away from drugs. Chief Minister reminiscing about his life as a professor, said that if a teacher wants to impart knowledge to a student, he must also study himself. In this way real knowledge can be imparted to the students. He said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that it will be possible to take the country to the peak of development in the future only by gaining knowledge. The current state government has provided 33 percent reservation for women in the workplace.

Chief Minister Dr. Manik Saha urged the students, teachers and parents to observe Har Ghar Tiranga programme on the occasion of 75th Independence Day from 13th to 15th August. Chief Minister inaugurated a computer lab before the felicitation programme in the school. At the programme, Raja Saha, a student of the school, handed over his hand drawn portrait of the Chief Minister to Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha.

At the programme, Education Minister Ratan Lal Nath said that one of the goals of the current government of the state is development of the education sector. He said that the present government has taken various steps to provide quality education in the state. NCERT courses have been introduced from class I to class XII. Besides, 135 vocational subjects, Super-30 Scheme, Centralized Question Paper System, Notun Disha Scheme, Merit Tests on Science and Mathematics have been introduced. The education minister said that Vidyalay Chalo Abhiyan has been launched to bring back dropout students in the new education policy. Nabadal Banik, president of the SMC committee of the school, gave welcome speech at the programme. Sepahijala District Magistrate Vishwasree B, District Education Officer Habul Lodh, Headmaster of the school and others were present.
