Chief Minister's Appeal

Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha has appealed to the people of the state to make the Har Ghar Tiranga programme a successful one in the state. In the appeal, Chief Minister said, "The Indian National Flag represents the hopes and aspirations of the people of India. It is the symbol of our national pride. Over the decades, several people including members of armed forces have laid down their lives to keep the tricolor flying in its full glory.

A campaign of 'Har Ghar Tiranga' under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav has been initiated to encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the 75th year of India's independence.

Our relationship with the flag has always been more formal and institutional than personal.
