The government aims overall development of education sector, enunciated Education Minister Ratan Lal Nath after inaugurating Girl's Hostel at Twidu Higher Secondary School yesterday. Others present during the inaugural programme were MLA Sindhu Kumar Jamatia, MLA Ranjit Das, ADM of Gomati district Pankaj Chakraborty, Amarpur SDM Asit Kumar Das and District Education Officer Lkhan Chandra Das. The programme was presided over by MDC Shibsenslian Kaipeng.

NCERT syllabus has been started recently from Class 1 to Class 10 for development of quality education in the state. Besides, 135 professional education programs and Super 30 scheme has been started in the state. Mission Vidyajyoti scheme has been started in 100 schools of the state. Vidyalay Chalo Abhiyan has been started under the new education policy to help students return back to schooling for those who have left schooling due to certain circumstances.

It is to be noted that this Girl's Hostel has been built at the cost of 2 crore 40 lakh rupees. MLA Sindhu Kumar Jamatia handed over 15 ceiling fans and 3 computers to Twidubari HS School, 15 ceiling fans to Tetuibari High School, 3 computers to Ampii English Medium School and 3 computers to Ampii HS School.
