Inauguration of Tribal Rest House at Kalachara

State government is working on priority for the

overall development of tribal people: Chief Minister

The state government is working on priority for the overall development of the tribal. The state government is sincere in protecting the traditional culture of the tribal people. A two-day public holiday has been declared on the occasion of the traditional Garia Puja of the tribal people and Agartala Airport is named after Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya. Chief Minister Professor Dr. Manik Saha said this while inaugurating Tribal Rest House at Kalachara in Sabroom on 11th August, 2022.

Chief Minister said that the country is moving forward under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The Prime Minister is also very sincere in the development of the tribal people. Few days ago, Draupadi Murmu of Odisha's tribal community was elected to the country's highest constitutional post of President which is one of the signs of the prime minister's sincerity towards the tribal people. MLA Shankar Roy and local public representatives were present at the inauguration programme.
