Union Minister of State for Social Justice at the meeting of District Coordination and Monitoring Committee in Belonia

A meeting of the District Coordination and Monitoring Committee on the development programme of South Tripura district was held yesterday in the auditorium of Belonia Circuit House under the chairmanship of Union Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment Pratima Bhowmik. In the meeting various schemes like PM Awas Yojana, Gram Sadak Yojana, Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission, Swachh Bharat Mission, Jal Jeevan Mission, PWD, Health, Education, Forest, Social Welfare and Social Education, Rural Development, Fisheries, Animal Resource Development Department, Agriculture, Horticulture, Water Resources etc. and developmental works are reviewed.

In the meeting, Union Minister of State for Social Justice emphasized on how to deliver the benefits of different schemes and developmental works to the people. She laid special emphasis on completing the work on time. In the meeting, the Union Minister of State said that self-help groups have a major role to play in strengthening the rural economy. District Self Help Groups should be involved in various economic processes. If self-help groups become self-reliant rural households will also become self-reliant. She also emphasized on speedy completion of developmental works in the district. Minister said that on September 17, different items will be distributed among the selected Divyangjans simultaneously in all the block areas of the district. For the economic prosperity of Tripura, she laid special emphasis on development of fisheries, agriculture and animal resources. The progress of Amrit Sarovar mission in the district was also discussed in the meeting.

In the meeting, the Union Minister of State laid emphasis on the coordination between public representatives and government officials in implementing developmental projects. She said that Central and State Government schemes should be delivered to the real beneficiaries.
