To control waterborne diseases, government has taken target to provide clean drinking water to every house by December 2022. Various steps have been taken to speed up the work. Providing civic services is one of the prioritised fields of government.

Presiding over the programme ICA Minister Sushanta Choudhury said, there are some great personalities in history who will always remain alive. Their ideals and thoughts inspire us. We always feel their need. He said, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya is one of the prominent national heroes of India. His ideologies are similar to that of Mahatma Gandhi. He has tried to inspire India about the greatness of Indian tradition. Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya's integral humanism has far-reaching implications.
