**“Glimpses of Tripura’s Development Since 1949”**

**To build a self-reliant Tripura, the state should have a history of development: Deputy Chief Minister**

Every state needs to have a political and economic history as well as the history of development. The present government has made an effort to present to the public the real and informative history of the state’s development. Deputy Chief Minister Jishnu Dev varma said this while unveiling a coffee table book titled ‘Glimpses of Tripura’s Development Since 1949’ at the press conference hall of the secretariat on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. This coffee table book has been published by the Department of Planning and Coordination of State Government.

Unveiling the cover of the coffee table book, Deputy Chief Minister said that Tripura has celebrated 50 years of full statehood this year. On the occasion of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Tripura state, the state government took this initiative to publish books on the development of different fields of the state from 1949 till now.
