## CM inaugurated 8 new services at

**Tripura Medical College (TMC)** 

Tripura Medical college plays an important role in the health sector of the state. The Government is eyeing TMC to occupy a good position in the medical field. Chief Minister Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha said this after inaugurating 8 new services at Tripura Medical College and Dr. B R Ambedkar Teaching Hospital yesterday. In the inaugural function, the chief guest spoke about the history of the establishment of this college. The CM said that in the state budget of the fiscal year 2024-25, more financial allocation has been kept for the development of infrastructure in other areas including health sector as the Prime Minister has emphasized on the development activities in the country. CM directed the managing authority to set up a Trauma Care Centers in TMC in the coming days. In this context he mentioned the establishment of 5 Trauma Care Center in the state.CM also said that the authority should look into the matter of implementing the newly launched Chief Minister Jan Arogya Yojana in the hospital. The central govt. has given approval for a dental college, opening of a De-Addiction center at Bisramganj and construction of a hospital for mother and child at AGMC. The CM said that the peoples' expectations have increased in line with the need of times and it is responsibility of all of us to fulfill those expectations. Attention should be paid to increase the number of post graduate seats in TMC because people now want specialist medical services.

At the opening ceremony, TMC Management Society Chairman Dr. Pramothesh Roy, CEO Swapan Saha and the principal of TMC Dr. Arindam Datta also gave speeches. Eight new services introduced are- new ICU complex in the new OPD building, cabins with modern facilities, new ENT operation theatre, National program for control of blindness, retina surgery facilities, skill labs for Tripura College of Nursing, community lab and 30 beds high end dialysis unit.
